### **FUN THINGS TO DO**

Check out the Galveston Destination Guide (copy provided) for a multitude of things to do. Island Savings are located between pages 32&33. Some fun things you might like to try are:

1. **Tree carving driving tour.** Hurricane Ike destroyed many trees in the Galveston Area in 2008. Artists carved numerous statues out of damaged trees in the area. A map of the tree sightings is available from the hosts/co-hosts.
2. **Iceland tour (ice carvings) and Festival of Lights at Moody Gardens** opens on Friday – Nov. 16<sup>th</sup>. The Fickingers attended these last year and it was really cool. Check on line for details and cost. **It's 9 degrees inside the ice carving venue, so be sure to bring your hat and gloves and buy their hand warmers!! They provide coats to wear.**
3. **Bryan Museum** – In addition to their epic story of Texas and the American West Exhibits they will be hosting a **Longhorn Legacy** gallery exhibit on Saturday, November 16th from 1:00 to 4:00. In addition, they have a **farmer's market** from 9-1:00 on Thursday and 3-6:00 on Sunday at the Museum.
4. **Pier 21 Theater located at 21<sup>st</sup> and Harborside** drive on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor showing:
  - a. **The Great Storm**, admission \$6, showings 11-5:00 Thursday – Monday – story of the 1900 hurricane that devastated Galveston.
  - b. **The Pirate Island of Jean Laffite**, admission \$6, showings 11:30-3:30 Thursday-Monday-
5. **Stroll the Strand** for unique shops and check out **La Kings Confectionary and Ice Cream Parlor** which is a throwback to the 1920s.
