The Medal of Honor is the United States of America's highest military honor awarded for personal acts of valor above and beyond the call of duty. Gainesville, Texas is home to the nation's only Medal of Honor Host City Program. When the program began in 2001 there were 150 living Recipients. By 2017, one third of those Recipients have visited Gainesville, TX through the Medal of Honor Host City Program. This weekend is the annual event. There are several activities but the two that we believe you may be interested in are as follows:

If you are arriving on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>April 15th</u>, <u>the Medal of Honor Welcoming Motorcade</u> is something to see. The motorcade will begin at DFW Airport and will continue North on Interstate 35 to Gainesville arriving late afternoon.

Saturday, April 18th – Medal of Honor Parade in downtown Gainesville is the largest military parade in Cooke County's history. The parade starts at 10 AM and will be on California St between the Santa Fe Depot by the railroad tracks and Braums. For more details visit: medalofhonorhostcity.com & like our Facebook page

The Medal of Honor Park is on California Street right as you get off of I-35.

<u>The Morton Museum</u> – 210 S Dixon St. – open 10 AM to 5 PM Monday thru Friday and 2 PM to 4 PM on Saturday. The current exhibit is from the 1900 – 1950 era.

Santa Fe Depot Museum – 605 E California St, Gainesville – open 10 AM to 12 Noon Monday thru Friday. Contains memorabilia from Camp Howze, Harvey House, the Railroad, Coco Cola, Gainesville Circus and the Texas Ranger.

Leonard Park and Frank Buck Zoo are located on California Street just West of Interstate 35.

<u>Saint Peter's Catholic Church</u> is a beautiful historical church located 4 miles West of Gainesville on Highway 82 in Lindsay Texas. The first Mass in the new church was on Easter Sunday April 17, 1892.
